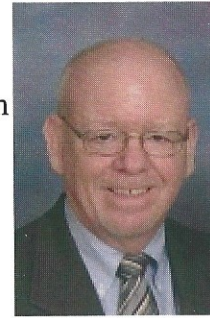

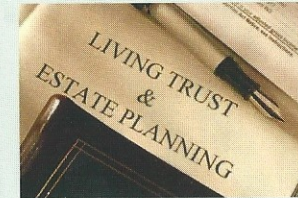

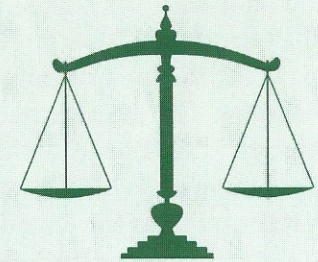

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Estate Planning

Getting legal affairs in order to simplify administration of your estate when life ends, a plan for current or future care, and peace of mind are important benefits of an individualized estate plan. ALTCS Planning

You do not have to exhaust your life savings to qualify for the ALTCS governmental program that pays for the bulk of long-term care expenses in Arizona. The average nursing home private pay rate is \$7,430 per month, which can quickly deplete most individual's savings. ALTCS has been referred to as the "nursing home insurance plan for the middle class". Most people do not automatically qualify for ALTCS because like many government programs there are strict requirements that must be met. There are ways to speed up your eligibility and immediately qualify for ALTCS, while reserving your assets for your loved one(s). In addition to skilled nursing care, ALTCS provides coverage for services including home health care, adult day care, and assisted living.

Elder Law

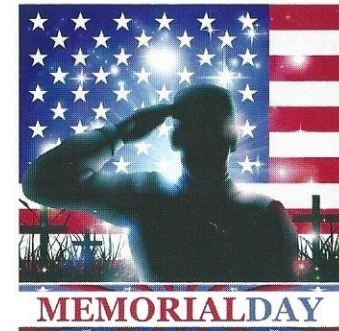
